- Cross the river and browse the Munich Museum gift shop / toilets (not bath rooms)









- Dinner at a local restaurant outside




# Day 4: Saturday Prague, Czechia


Check into St. George hotel in the downtown district. Street car to restaurant Zeughauskeller,
